



## VINYL & ADHESIVE REMOVAL - GENERAL PROCEDURE

### **VINYL**

1. Clean the area with soap and water.
2. Ensure the painted surface has no visible damage.
3. Proceed with applying even heat using electrical heat source (electrical heat gun).
4. Do not overheat the surface (should be warm to touch) or paint damage may occur.
5. Proceed with gently pulling edge of vinyl until vinyl removal is complete

### **ADHESIVE**

1. Once all vinyl is removed, inspect surface for adhesive residue.
2. All adhesive residue should be removed by applying 3M General Purpose Adhesive Cleaner and Wax Remover (Part# 08985)
3. Closely follow 3M General Purpose Adhesive Cleaner directions for use, listed on container.
4. Be sure to follow ALL safety regulations on container.
